**IMMIGRATION**

**The Immigration (Transit Visa) (Amendment) Order 1995**

*Made* - - - - - *5th October 1995*  
*Laid before Parliament* *23rd October 1995*  
*Coming into force* - - *24th October 1995*

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 1A(1) and (2) of the Immigration (Carriers' Liability) Act 1987(1), the Secretary of State hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Immigration (Transit Visa) (Amendment) Order 1995 and shall come into force on 24th October 1995.
2. For the Schedule to the Immigration (Transit Visa) Order 1993(2) there shall be substituted the Schedule to this Order.
