## Amendment of regulation 2 of the principal Regulations

- 2. In regulation 2 of the principal Regulations (interpretation)—
  - (a) after the definition of "scheduled drug" insert—

""suspended by direction of the Tribunal" means suspended as respects the provision of general medical services to patients by a direction of the Tribunal made pursuant to section 32A(2) or section 32B(1) of the Act(1) or to any provisions in England and Wales or Northern Ireland corresponding to those provisions;"; and

(b) after the definition of "treatment" insert—

""the Tribunal" means the Tribunal constituted under section 29 of the Act."(2).
