**The Natural History Museum
(Authorised Repositories) Order 1995**

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 10(2) of the British Museum Act 1963⁽¹⁾ and now vested in him⁽²⁾, hereby, with the agreement of the Trustees of the Natural History Museum, makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Natural History Museum (Authorised Repositories) Order 1995 and shall come into force on 31st March 1995.

2. For paragraph 4 of Part II of Schedule 3 to the British Museum Act 1963⁽³⁾ there shall be substituted the following paragraph:—

“4. The site in Wandsworth known as 75 Kimber Road SW18 4NX.”.
