**The Offshore Installations (Prevention of Fire and
Explosion, and Emergency Response) Regulations 1995**

[^{F1}Arrangements for early warning of major accidents

22C.—(1) This regulation applies only in relation to external waters.

(2) The duty holder must make arrangements—

- (a) for providing early warning of a major accident to the Maritime and Coastguard Agency;
and
- (b) for providing more detailed information about such an accident as soon as it becomes
available,

but nothing in this paragraph is to be taken as imposing a requirement which is imposed by regulation 4(3)(c) and paragraph 2(k) of Schedule 2 to the Merchant Shipping (Oil Pollution Preparedness, Response and Co-operation Convention) Regulations 1998 (arrangements for early warning of major environmental incidents).]
