PART III

TRANSITIONAL PROVISION

**Election of councillors in Nottingham in 1997 and subsequent years**

7.—(1) The City of Nottingham (Electoral Arrangements) Order 1976<sup>(1)</sup> shall have effect subject to the provisions of this article.

(2) Elections of all councillors of the Nottingham City Council shall be held simultaneously on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 1997, 2000, 2003 and every fourth year after 2003<sup>(2)</sup>.

(3) The term of office of any councillor so elected shall be, in the case of the councillors elected in 1997 and 2000, three years and, in any other case, four years.

(4) On the fourth day after any such elections—

- (a) the persons who were councillors immediately before those elections shall retire; and
- (b) the newly elected councillors shall come into office.
