# The Employer's Contributions Reimbursement Regulations 1996

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State for Social Security, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 27, 34(3) and (7), 35(1) and (3) and 36 of the Jobseekers Act 1995<sup>M2</sup> and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, by this instrument which is made before the end of a period of 6 months beginning with the coming into force of the enactments under which it is made<sup>M3</sup>, hereby makes the following Regulations:
