The Personal and Occupational Pension Schemes(Pensions Ombudsman) Regulations 1996

The Secretary of State for Social Security, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 146(4) and (6)(b) and (c), 151A, 181(1) and 182(2) and (3) of the Pension Schemes Act 1993^{MI}, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, after agreement by the Occupational Pensions Board that proposals to make these Regulations should not be referred to them^{M2}, by this instrument, which contains regulations which are consequential upon sections 157 and 160 of the Pensions Act 1995, hereby makes the following Regulations:
