**The Bridgend and District National Health
Service Trust (Dissolution) Order 1996**

Made - - - - - *29th January 1996*

Coming into force - - - - - *1st April 1996*

The Secretary of State for Wales, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 126(3) of the National Health Service Act 1977(1) and section 5(1) of, and paragraph 29(1) of Schedule 2 to, the National Health Service and Community Care Act 1990(2) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, considering it appropriate in the interests of the health service to make this Order(3), and after completion of the consultation prescribed under paragraph 29(3) of Schedule 2 to the latter Act(4), hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Bridgend and District National Health Service Trust (Dissolution) Order 1996 and shall come into force on 1st April 1996.

Dissolution of NHS trust

2. The Bridgend and District National Health Service Trust established by the Bridgend and District National Health Service Trust (Establishment) Order 1992(5) is hereby dissolved, and accordingly that Order is hereby revoked.
