**The A23 Trunk Road (Croydon) Red Route  
(Prescribed Route) Traffic Order 1996**

**Interpretation**

**2. In this Order**

- (a) cause includes permit;
- (b) “Purley Way” means that length of the A23 Trunk Road in the London Borough of Croydon known as Purley Way;
- (c) “Brighton Road” means that length of the A23 Trunk Road in the London Borough of Croydon known as Brighton Road;
- (d) “Chipstead Valley Road”, “Stafford Road”, “Denning Avenue”, and “Lion Green Road” means the roads of those names in the London Borough of Croydon;
- (e) “north eastern triangular island” means the triangular island site situated on the east side of the southbound carriageway of Purley Way at its junction with the north eastern arm of Stafford Road;
- (f) “south western triangular island” means the triangular island site situated on the west of Purley Way at its junction with the south western arm of Stafford Road.
