**The Environmentally Sensitive Areas (West Penwith) Designation (Amendment) Order 1996**

Whereas, pursuant to section 18(1) of the Agriculture Act 1986<sup>(1)</sup>, the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food has by order designated an area in West Penwith as an environmentally sensitive area;

Now, therefore, the said Minister, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 18(1) and (4)<sup>(2)</sup> of the said Act, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, with the consent of the Treasury, hereby makes the following Order:

**Title and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Environmentally Sensitive Areas (West Penwith) Designation (Amendment) Order 1996 and shall come into force on 17th April 1996.

**Amendment**

2.—(1) The Environmentally Sensitive Areas (West Penwith) Designation Order 1986<sup>(3)</sup> shall be amended in accordance with paragraph (2) of this article.

(2) In paragraph (1) of article 6 (rates of payment under agreement), for “£70” there shall be substituted “£75”.

**Saving**

3. Article 2 of this Order shall not apply in respect of any annual payment to a farmer which relates wholly or in part to any period before 1st April 1996.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order amends the Environmentally Sensitive Areas (West Penwith) Designation Order 1986 (S.I.1986/2251, amended by S.I. 1992/51, S.I. 1994/250 and S.I. 1994/933) which designated an area in West Penwith as an environmentally sensitive area, in compliance with Title VII of Council Regulation (EEC) No. 2328/91 (OJ No. L218, 6.8.91, p.1) on improving the efficiency of agricultural structures. This Order complies with Council Regulation (EEC) No. 2078/92 (OJ No. L215, 30.7.92, p.85) on agricultural production methods compatible with the requirements of protection of the environment and the maintenance of the countryside which superseded Council Regulation (EEC) No. 2328/91.

Subject to a saving provision, the Order amends the rates of payments to be made by the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food pursuant to a management agreement made under section 18(3) of the Agriculture Act 1986 (articles 2 and 3).
