LICENSING (LIQUOR)

**The Licensing (Special Hours
Certificates) (Amendment) Rules 1996**

Made - - - - - *25th March 1996*

Coming into force - - - - - *1st May 1996*

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 91 of the Licensing Act 1964⁽¹⁾, hereby makes the following Rules:

1.—(1) These Rules may be cited as the Licensing (Special Hours Certificates) (Amendment) Rules 1996 and shall come into force on 1st May 1996.

2.—(1) The Licensing (Special Hours Certificates) Rules 1982⁽²⁾ shall be amended as follows.

(2) In rule 3(1) after “special hours certificate” there shall be inserted “under section 77 or 77A of the Licensing Act 1964”⁽³⁾.

(3) In rule 3A after “section 77” there shall be inserted “or section 77A”.

(4) In rule 7 for “or 81” there shall be substituted “, 77A or 81”.

(5) For rule 8 there shall be substituted—

“**8.**—(1) A special hours certificate shall be in one of the forms specified in Part I of the Schedule to these Rules, or in a form to the like effect.

(2) A declaration that a provisional special hours certificate is to be final shall be in the form specified in Part II of the Schedule to these Rules, or in a form to the like effect.”.

3. For the Schedule to the Licensing (Special Hours Certificates) Rules 1982 there shall be substituted the Schedule to these Rules.

PART I

LICENSING ACT 1964*Special Hours Certificate*

At the licensing sessions held at _____ on the _____ day of _____ 19____, for the _____ Licensing District.

The licensing justices for the said licensing district, being satisfied as respects the licensed premises known as

- (a) that a music and dancing licence is in force as respects the premises; and
- (b) that [the premises are] [the following part of the premises, that is to say, is] structurally adapted and bona fide [used] [intended to be used] for the purpose of providing for persons resorting to the premises music and dancing and substantial refreshment to which the sale of intoxicating liquor is ancillary,

hereby grant under section 77 of the Licensing Act 1964, this special hours certificate as respects the said premises.

- (a) that a music and dancing licence, whether or not subject to a condition that it shall be of no effect until confirmed, is in force as respects the premises; and
- (b) that [the premises are] [the following part of the premises, that is to say, _____ is] intended to be used, and, if completed in accordance with plans deposited with the licensing justices, will be structurally adapted for the purpose of providing for persons resorting to the premises music and dancing and substantial refreshment to which the sale of intoxicating liquor is ancillary,

hereby grant under section 77A of the Licensing Act 1964 this special hours certificate as respects the said premises.

This certificate is [granted subject to the limitations endorsed hereon, and] shall not be valid until it has been declared final by the licensing justices.
