**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A205 Trunk Road (Upper Richmond Road West)  
Red Route (Prescribed Route) Traffic Order 1997**

*Made* - - - - - *31st January 1997*

*Coming into force* - - - - - *12th February 1997*

The Traffic Director for London, following a direction given to him by the Secretary of State for Transport under section 58(1) of the Road Traffic Act 1991<sup>(1)</sup> and in exercise of the powers conferred on the Secretary of State by section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>(2)</sup>, and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order:—

**Commencement and citation**

1. This Order may be cited as The A205 Trunk Road (Upper Richmond Road West) Red Route (Prescribed Route) Traffic Order 1997, and shall come into force on 12th February 1997.

**Interpretation**

2. In this Order—

- (a) causing includes permitting;
- (b) “disabled person’s badge” and “disabled person’s vehicle” have the same meanings as in regulation 2(1) of the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) Regulations 1986<sup>(3)</sup>, and “relevant position” in relation to a disabled person’s badge has the same meaning as in regulation 2A of those regulations.

**Prohibition**

3. Subject to the provisions of article 4 below, no person shall cause any motor vehicle proceeding in Upper Richmond Road West in the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames to enter the south-east arm of Sheen Lane (which fronts Nos. 137 to 141 and Parkway House, Sheen Lane).

## **Exemptions**

4. Nothing in article 3 above shall apply to—
- (a) any person causing any vehicle to enter the said south-east arm of Sheen Lane for the purpose of loading or unloading a vehicle in that arm;
  - (b) any person using a disabled person's vehicle which displays a disabled person's badge in the relevant position;
  - (c) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a traffic warden; or
  - (d) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.

## **Revocations**

5. The A205 Trunk Road (Upper Richmond Road West) Red Route (Prescribed Route No.1) Experimental Traffic Order 1995(4) is hereby revoked.
