# The Housing Benefit (Information from Landlords and Agents) Regulations 1997

Made - - - - 8th October 1997

Laid before Parliament 13th October 1997

Coming into force - - 3rd November 1997

The Secretary of State for Social Security, in exercise of powers conferred on her by sections 113, 126A, 189(1) and (4) to (6) and 191 of the Social Security Administration Act 1992<sup>M1</sup> and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, by this instrument, which contains only regulations made by virtue of or consequential upon section 11 of the Social Security Administration (Fraud) Act 1997<sup>M2</sup> and is made before the end of the period of six months beginning with the coming into force of that section and after consultation with organisations appearing to her to be representative of the authorities concerned<sup>M3</sup>, hereby makes the following Regulations:
