**The Social Security (National Insurance Number
Information: Exemption) Regulations 1997**

Made - - - - *7th November 1997*
Laid before Parliament *10th November 1997*
Coming into force - - *1st December 1997*

The Secretary of State for Social Security, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 1(1C), 189(1), (3) and (4) and 191 of the Social Security Administration Act 1992⁽¹⁾, and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, by this instrument which contains only regulations made by virtue of section 19 of the Social Security Administration (Fraud) Act 1997 and is made before the end of the period of six months beginning with the coming into force of that enactment⁽²⁾, and in so far as the regulations relate to housing benefit and council tax benefit after consultation with organisations appearing to her to be representative of the authorities concerned⁽³⁾, hereby makes the following Regulations:
