(2) In the last sentence of the words substituted as mentioned in paragraph (1), for "the date inserted above" substitute "the date this Notice is given".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Secure Tenancies (Notices) Regulations 1987 to rectify an error in an amendment made to those Regulations by the Secure Tenancies (Notices) (Amendment) Regulations 1997. The amendment is to the form of notice of seeking possession to be given by a landlord to a secure tenant with a periodic tenancy.
