"47A. "Child" and "young person" are defined by regulation 2(1) of the Housing Renewal Grants Regulations (S.I.1996/2890) as follows:

- "child": a person under the age of 16;
- "young person": a person, other than someone who is in receipt of income support or is receiving advanced education (defined in the Income Support (General) Regulations 1987 (S.I. 1987/1967)), aged 16 or over but under 19 who is treated as a child for the purposes of section 142 of the Social Security Contributions and Benefits Act 1992.".
