## The London Cab Order 1998

## Scale of fares

3. For paragraph 40 (scales of fares excluding extras) there shall be substituted the following-
"40.-(1) Subject to sub-paragraph (2) below, the fare payable for the hiring of a motor cab shall be according to the following scale-
(a) a hiring charge of $£ 1.00$, and
(b) in respect of any part of the hiring during which the cab travels at a speed exceeding 10.1 miles an hour, at the rate of 20 p for 231 metres or, if the fare shown on the taximeter is $£ 9.40$ or more, at the rate of 20 p for 154 metres, and
(c) in respect of any part of the hiring during which the cab is stationary or travels at a speed not exceeding 10.1 miles an hour, at the rate of 20 p for 51 seconds or, if the fare shown on the taximeter is $£ 9.40$ or more, at the rate of 20 p for 34 seconds.
(2) In any case where the sum arrived at in accordance with sub-paragraph (1) above-
(a) is less than $£ 1.40$, the fare payable shall be $£ 1.40$; or
(b) exceeds $£ 1.40$ but is not a multiple of 20 p, the fare payable shall be the sum so arrived at rounded up to the next highest multiple of 20p."
