## **MAGISTRATES' COURTS**

The Licensing (Fees) (Amendment) Order 1998

Made - - - - 24th January 1998 Laid before Parliament 26th January 1998 Coming into force - - 1st February 1998

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 29(1) and 198(2) of the Licensing Act 1964(1), hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Licensing (Fees) (Amendment) Order 1998 and shall come into force on 1st February 1998.
- **2.** The Schedule to the Licensing (Fees) Order 1978(**2**) shall be amended by inserting after the entry relating to transfer (sections 8, 138 and 145), the following entries;

"Approval of prospective licensee—s.8A(3)	£30
Grant of interim authority—s.9A	£10".
