**Note**

Under section 3(2) of the Firearms Act 1968 it is an offence for a person to sell or transfer to any person in the United Kingdom, other than a registered firearms dealer, any firearm or ammunition to which this permit relates, unless that other person produces a firearms certificate authorising him to purchase or acquire it, or shows that he is, by virtue of the Firearms Acts entitled to purchase or acquire the firearm or ammunition without holding a certificate.
