PART 1

OVERRIDING OBJECTIVE

The overriding objective

1.1.—(1) These Rules are a F1 ... procedural code with the overriding objective of enabling the court to deal with cases justly [F2 and at proportionate cost].

- (2) Dealing with a case justly [^{F3} and at proportionate cost] includes, so far as is practicable—
 - (a) ensuring that the parties are on an equal footing [^{F4}and can participate fully in proceedings, and that parties and witnesses can give their best evidence];
 - (b) saving expense;
 - (c) dealing with the case in ways which are proportionate—
 - (i) to the amount of money involved;
 - (ii) to the importance of the case;
 - (iii) to the complexity of the issues; and
 - (iv) to the financial position of each party;
 - (d) ensuring that it is dealt with expeditiously and fairly; ^{F5}...
 - (e) allotting to it an appropriate share of the court's resources, while taking into account the need to allot resources to other cases [^{F6}; and]
- $I^{F7}(f)$ enforcing compliance with rules, practice directions and orders.]
