OVERRIDING OBJECTIVE

Application by the court of the overriding objective

- 1.2** The court must seek to give effect to the overriding objective when it—
- (a) exercises any power given to it by the Rules; or
 - (b) interprets any rule [^{F1}, subject to [^{F2}rules 76.2 and 79.2]].
