ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF SERVICE

Contents of acknowledgment of service

10.5 An acknowledgment of service must—

- (a) be signed by the defendant or [^{F1}the defendant's] legal representative; and
- (b) include the defendant's address for service.

[^{F2}(Rule 6.23 makes provision in relation to addresses for service.)]

[^{F3}(Rule 19.8A modifies this Part where a notice of claim is served under that rule to bind a person not a party to the claim)]
