**Determination of rate of payment by court officer**

**14.11.**—(1) A court officer may exercise the powers of the court under rule 14.10(4) where the amount outstanding (including costs) is not more than £50,000.

(2) Where a court officer is to determine the time and rate of payment, [<sup>F1</sup>this must be done] without a hearing.
