Court documents to be sealed

- **2.6.**—(1) The court must seal^(GL) the following documents on issue—
 - (a) the claim form; and
 - (b) any other document which a rule or practice direction requires it to seal.
- [F1(2) The court may place the seal on the document by hand, by printing or electronically.]
- (3) A document [F2appearing] to bear the court's seal (GL) shall be admissible in evidence without further proof.
