## PART 26

### CASE MANAGEMENT—PRELIMINARY STAGE

#### Stay to allow for settlement of the case

**26.4.**—(1) A party may, when filing the completed allocation questionnaire, make a written request for the proceedings to be stayed<sup>(GL)</sup> while the parties try to settle the case by alternative dispute resolution<sup>(GL)</sup> or other means.

- (2) Where—
  - (a) all parties request a stay<sup>(GL)</sup> under paragraph (1); or
  - (b) the court, of its own initiative, considers that such a stay would be appropriate,

the court will direct that the proceedings be stayed for one month.

(3) The court may extend the stay  $^{(GL)}$  until such date or for such specified period as it considers appropriate.

(4) Where the court stays<sup>(GL)</sup> the proceedings under this rule, the claimant must tell the court if a settlement is reached.

(5) If the claimant does not tell the court by the end of the period of the stay<sup>(GL)</sup> that a settlement has been reached, the court will give such directions as to the management of the case as it considers appropriate.
