THE SMALL CLAIMS TRACK

**Conduct of the hearing**

- 27.8.**—(1) The court may adopt any method of proceeding at a hearing that it considers to be fair.
- (2) Hearings will be informal.
  - (3) The strict rules of evidence do not apply.
  - (4) The court need not take evidence on oath.
  - (5) The court may limit cross-examination<sup>(GL)</sup>.
  - (6) The court must give reasons for its decision.
