*Case Management]*

**General power of the court to rectify matters where there has been an error of procedure**

**3.10** Where there has been an error of procedure such as a failure to comply with a rule or practice direction—

- (a) the error does not invalidate any step taken in the proceedings unless the court so orders;  
and
- (b) the court may make an order to remedy the error.
