### [F1]F2Scope of this Section

- **36.16.**—(1) Where this Section applies Section I does not apply.
- (2) This Section applies to an offer to settle where the parties have followed the RTA Protocol [F3 or the EL/PL Protocol] and started proceedings under Part 8 in accordance with Practice Direction 8B ("the Stage 3 Procedure").
- (3) A reference to the "Court [ $^{F4}$ Proceedings] Pack Form" is a reference to the form used in the  $^{F5}$ ... Protocol.
- (4) Nothing in this Section prevents a party making an offer to settle in whatever way that party chooses, but if the offer is not made in accordance with this Section, it will not have any costs consequences.]]
