CHANGE OF SOLICITOR

Solicitor acting for a party

42.1.—^[F1](1) Where the address for service of a party is the business address of ^[F2]that party's solicitor, the solicitor will be considered to be acting for that party until the provisions of this Part have been complied with.

^[F3](2) For the purposes of this Part, “solicitor” has the meaning set out in rule 6.2(d).]
