I GENERAL RULES ABOUT APPEALS

[F1Appellant's notice

- **52.4.**—(1) Where the appellant seeks permission from the appeal court it must be requested in the appellant's notice.
 - (2) The appellant must file the appellant's notice at the appeal court within—
 - (a) such period as may be directed by the lower court [F2(which may be longer or shorter than the period referred to in sub-paragraph (b))]; or
 - (b) where the court makes no such direction, [F321] days after the date of the decision of the lower court that the appellant wishes to appeal.
- (3) Unless the appeal court orders otherwise, [F4an appellant's notice] must be served on each respondent—
 - (a) as soon as practicable; and
- (b) in any event not later than 7 days, after it is filed.]
