I GENERAL RULES ABOUT APPEALS

[^{F1}Appellant's notice

52.4.—(1) Where the appellant seeks permission from the appeal court it must be requested in the appellant's notice.

(2) The appellant must file the appellant's notice at the appeal court within—

- (a) such period as may be directed by the lower court [^{F2}(which may be longer or shorter than the period referred to in sub-paragraph (b))]; or
- (b) where the court makes no such direction, [^{F3}21] days after the date of the decision of the lower court that the appellant wishes to appeal.

(3) Unless the appeal court orders otherwise, [^{F4}an appellant's notice] must be served on each respondent—

- (a) as soon as practicable; and
- (b) in any event not later than 7 days,

after it is filed.]
