**54.32.**—(1) A defendant and any other person served with the claim form who wishes to contest the claim or support it on additional grounds must file and serve with the acknowledgement of service—

- (a) detailed grounds for contesting the claim or supporting it on additional grounds; and
  - (b) any written evidence.
- (2) Rule 8.6(1) does not apply.
- (3) No written evidence may be relied on unless—
- (a) it has been served in accordance with any—
    - (i) rule in this Section; or
    - (ii) direction of the court; or
  - (b) the court gives permission.]]
