## [F1Acknowledgment of service

- **58.6.**—(1) A defendant must file an acknowledgment of service in every case.
- (2) Unless paragraph (3) applies, the period for filing an acknowledgment of service is 14 days after service of the claim form.
- (3) Where the claim form is served out of the jurisdiction, or on the agent of a defendant who is overseas, the time periods provided by [F2rules 6.12(3), 6.35 and 6.37(5)] apply after service of the claim form.]
