**AMENDMENTS WITH RESPECT TO INCOME-
RELATED BENEFITS AND JOBSEEKER'S ALLOWANCE**

Jobseeker's Allowance: Periods of interruption of employment

16.—(1) Regulation 47A of the Jobseeker's Allowance Regulations (jobseeking periods: periods of interruption of employment) ^{M1} shall be renumbered as regulation 47A(1) and in subparagraph (za) of that paragraph the words "and is still current on 1st December 1997" shall be omitted.

(2) After the renumbered paragraph (1) the following paragraph shall be added—

"(2) In paragraph (1) "period of interruption of employment" in relation to a period prior to 7th October 1996 has the same meaning as it had in the Benefits Act by virtue of section 25A of that Act (determination of days for which unemployment benefit is payable) ^{M2} as in force on 6th October 1996."
