**The Social Security and Child Support (Decisions
and Appeals) Amendment (No. 3) Regulations 1999**

The Secretary of State for Social Security, in exercise of powers conferred by sections 10A, 20(2), 24A and 79(1), (3), (6) and (7) of the Social Security Act 1998⁽¹⁾ and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, after consultation with the Council on Tribunals in accordance with section 8 of the Tribunals and Inquiries Act 1992⁽²⁾, by this Instrument, which contains only regulations made by virtue of, or consequential upon, that section 20(2) or paragraph 24, 31 or 33 of Schedule 7 to the Social Security Contributions (Transfer of Functions, etc.) Act 1999⁽³⁾ and which is made before the end of the period of six months beginning with the coming into force of those provisions⁽⁴⁾, makes the following Regulations:
