The Export of Goods (Control) (Iraq and Kuwait Sanctions)
(Amendment) Order 1999

Made - - - 23rd June 1999

Coming into force 14th July 1999

The Secretary of State, in exercise of powers conferred by section 1 of the Import, Export and Customs Powers (Defence) Act 1939(a) and now vested in him(b), hereby makes the following Order:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Export of Goods (Control) (Iraq and Kuwait Sanctions) (Amendment) Order 1999 and shall come into force on 14th July 1999.
- 2. In article 3 of the Export of Goods (Control) (Iraq and Kuwait Sanctions) Order 1990(c), the words "in writing" shall be inserted after the word "licence" where it first appears.
