The Seeds (Fees) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1999

Made	29th June 1999
Laid before Parliament	30th June 1999
Coming into force	30th July 1999

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, the Secretary of State for Scotland and the Secretary of State for Wales, acting jointly, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 16(1), (1A)(e) and (8) and 36 of the Plant Varieties and Seeds Act 1964(a), after consultation in accordance with the said section 16(1) with representatives of such interests as appear to them to be concerned, hereby make the following Regulations:

Title and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Seeds (Fees) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1999 and shall come into force on 30th July 1999.

Amendment

2. After regulation 3 (fees) of the Seeds (Fees) Regulations 1985(b) there shall be inserted-

"4. Regulation 3 above shall apply to matters listed in column (1) of Schedules 1 to 6 arising in relation to breeder's confirmations as it does to matters so listed arising in relation to official certificates.".
