## NATIONAL HEALTH SERVICE, ENGLAND

The National Health Service (Choice of Medical Practitioner) Amendment Regulations 1999

Made - - - - 27th November 1999
Laid before Parliament 29th November 1999
Coming into force - 21st December 1999

The Secretary of State for Health, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 28F(1) and (2) and 126(4) of the National Health Service Act 1977(1) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:
