The Distress for Rent (Amendment) (No. 3) Rules 1999

*Made - - - - 26th November 1999* 

Coming into force in accordance with rule 1

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 8 of the Law of Distress Amendment Act 1888(a), and section 3 of the Law of Distress Amendment Act 1895(b), hereby makes the following Rules:

#### Citation and commencement

- 1. These Rules may be cited as the Distress for Rent (Amendment) (No. 3) Rules 1999 and shall come into force:
  - (a) as to rule 2(b), on 31st January 2000; and
  - (b) as to the remainder of these Rules, on 20th December 1999.

### **Amendments to Distress for Rent Rules 1988**

- 2. The following entries in Appendix 3 to the Distress for Rent Rules 1988(c) shall be deleted:
  - (a) the entry relating to Bridgwater; and
  - (b) the entries relating to Grays Thurrock and Great Yarmouth.
