**The Sale of Solid Fuel Byelaws (Exemption from Repeal)
(Scotland) Order 1999**

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 59(6)(a) of the Local Government etc. (Scotland) Act 1994^(a) hereby makes the following Order:

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Sale of Solid Fuel Byelaws (Exemption from Repeal) (Scotland) Order 1999 and shall come into force on 31st December 1999.

(2) In this Order “the 1994 Act” means the Local Government etc. (Scotland) Act 1994.

Provisions

2. The byelaws set out in the Schedule to this Order are hereby exempted for the purposes of section 59(6)(a) of the 1994 Act and, accordingly, shall not cease to have effect on 31st December 1999.
