Child support appeals involving issues that arise in other cases

24. [^{F1} The circumstances prescribed under section 28ZB(6)(c) of the Child Support Act ^{M1}, where an appeal is pending against a decision in the case described in section 28ZB(1)(b) even though an appeal against the decision has not been brought (or, as the case may be, an application for [^{F2}permission] to appeal against the decision has not been made), is where the [^{F3}Secretary of State] —

- (a) certifies in writing that [^{F4}the Secretary of State] is considering appealing against that decision, and
- (b) considers that, if such an appeal were already determined, it would affect the determination of the appeal described in section 28ZB(1)(a).]
