#### *Persons Abroad*

- 21.** A decision of the Secretary of State made under—
- (a) regulation 2(1)(a) of the Social Security Benefit (Persons Abroad) Regulations 1975 <sup>M1</sup> whether to certify that it is consistent with the proper administration of the Contributions and Benefits Act that a disqualification under section 113(1)(a) of that Act should not apply;
  - (b) regulation 9(4) or (5) of those Regulations whether to allow a person to avoid disqualification for receiving benefit during a period of temporary absence from Great Britain longer than that specified in the regulation.
