# The Pensions on Divorce etc. (Provision of Information) Regulations 2000

Made - - - - 13th April 2000

Laid before Parliament 19th April 2000

Coming into force - - 1st December 2000

The Secretary of State for Social Security, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 168(1) and (4), 181(1)<sup>M1</sup> and 182(2) and (3) of the Pension Schemes Act 1993<sup>M2</sup> and sections 23(1) (a), (b)(i), (c)(i) and (2), 34(1)(b)(ii), 45(1) and 83(4) and (6) of the Welfare Reform and Pensions Act 1999 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, after consulting such persons as he considered appropriate<sup>M3</sup>, hereby makes the following Regulations:
