The Drinking Water (Undertakings) (England and Wales) Regulations 2000

Citation, commencement, extent and interpretation

- 1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Drinking Water (Undertakings) (England and Wales) Regulations 2000 and shall come into force on 14th June 2000.
 - (2) These Regulations extend to England and Wales.
 - (3) In these Regulations—
 - "the relevant enforcement authority" means—
 - (a) in relation to a company whose area of appointment as a water undertaker is wholly or mainly in Wales, the National Assembly for Wales M1; and
 - (b) in all other cases, the Secretary of State; and
 - "water supply zone" has the meaning given by regulation 2 of the Water Supply (Water Quality) Regulations 1989^{M2} .
