

## SCHEDULE **E+W+S**

### Amendments to primary legislation

1. The Employment Tribunals Act 1996 <sup>M1</sup> shall be amended as follows—
  - (a) In section 18(1) (cases where conciliation provisions apply) <sup>M2</sup>—
    - (i) at the end of paragraph (ff), the word “or” shall be omitted, and
    - (ii) after paragraph (g), there shall be inserted—

“or

(h) arising out of a contravention, or alleged contravention of regulation 7(2) of the Part-time Workers (Prevention of Less Favourable Treatment) Regulations 2000.”.
  - (b) In section 21 (jurisdiction of the Employment Appeal Tribunal) in subsection (1) (which specifies the proceedings and claims to which the section applies) <sup>M3</sup>—
    - (i) at the end of paragraph (h), the word “or” shall be omitted,
    - (ii) after paragraph (i) there shall be inserted—

“or

(j) the Part-time Workers (Prevention of Less Favourable Treatment) Regulations 2000.”.
