# The Social Security and Child Support (Miscellaneous Amendments) Regulations 2000

### Citation, commencement and interpretation

- 1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Social Security and Child Support (Miscellaneous Amendments) Regulations 2000 and shall come into force on 19th June 2000.
  - (2) In these Regulations—
- "the Claims and Payments Regulations" means the Social Security (Claims and Payments) Regulations 1987 MI;
- "the Departure Regulations" means the Child Support Departure Direction and Consequential Amendments Regulations 1996 M2;
- "the Industrial Injuries Regulations" means the Social Security (Industrial Injuries) (Prescribed Diseases) Regulations 1985 M3;
- "the Maintenance Regulations" means the Child Support (Maintenance Assessment Procedure) Regulations 1992 M4; and
- "the principal Regulations" means the Social Security and Child Support (Decisions and Appeals) Regulations 1999 M5.
