- 2. The following are hereby designated as institutions eligible for funding under Part I of the Education Act 1994—
 - (a) The Mathematical Association, a charitable unincorporated association having the registered charity number 313281,
 - (b) Plymouth City Council, and
 - (c) Start Education (EM) Limited, a company limited by shares having the registration number 3244584.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order designates The Mathematical Association, a charitable unincorporated association having the registered charity number 313281, Plymouth City Council and Start Education (EM) Limited, a company limited by shares having the registration number 3244584 as institutions eligible for funding under Part I of the Education Act 1994.

As a result of this Order, the Teacher Training Agency may make grants, loans or other payments in respect of expenditure incurred or to be incurred by the designated institutions for the purposes of the provision of teacher training and the provision of facilities, and the carrying on of other activities, which the institutions consider it necessary or desirable to provide or carry on for the purpose of or in connection with the provision of teacher training.
