The National Health Service (Professions Supplementary to Medicine) Amendment Regulations 2000

The Secretary of State for Health, in exercise of the powers conferred by paragraph 10(1) of Schedule 5 to the National Health Service Act 1977⁽¹⁾, after consulting in accordance with paragraph 11(1) of that Schedule bodies recognised by him as representing persons likely to be affected, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

Paragraph 10(1) of Schedule 5 was amended by the Health and Social Services and Social Security Adjudications Act 1983 (c. 41), Schedule 6, paragraph 3; by the Health and Social Security Act 1984 (c. 48), Schedule 3, paragraph 14, and Schedule 8, Part I; and by the Health Authorities Act 1995 (c. 17), Schedule 1, paragraph 60(c). As regards Wales, the functions of the Secretary of State under paragraph 10(1) of Schedule 5 to the 1977 Act are transferred to the National Assembly for Wales under article 2 of, and Schedule 1 to, the National Assembly for Wales (Transfer of Functions) Order 1999, S.I. 1999/672; these Regulations therefore extend only to England.
