# The Solicitors (Compensation for Inadequate Professional Services) Order 2000

Made - - - - 7th March 2000

Laid before Parliament 8th March 2000

Coming into force - - 31st March 2000

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the power conferred upon him by paragraph 3(2) of Schedule 1A to the Solicitors Act 1974(1), hereby makes the following Order–

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Solicitors (Compensation for Inadequate Professional Services) Order 2000 and shall come into force on 31st March 2000.
- **2.** In paragraph 3(1) of Schedule 1A to the Solicitors Act 1974, for the figure "£1,000" there shall be substituted the figure "£5,000".
