- 1. This Order may be cited as the Solicitors (Compensation for Inadequate Professional Services) Order 2000 and shall come into force on 31st March 2000.
- 2. In paragraph 3(1) of Schedule 1A to the Solicitors Act 1974, for the figure "£1,000" there shall be substituted the figure "£5,000".
